On **Saturday, January 13, 2018**, the Croton-on-Hudson Fire Department will be conducting a training exercise – *with the approval of Village Manager Janine King* - **at Kaplan's Pond** (at the corner of Lounsbury Road and Giglio Court).

In order to perform this exercise reviewing Ice Rescue techniques, we will be cutting holes in the ice and conducting simulated rescues of “victims.”

***This exercise will begin around 8:00 AM and will end mid-afternoon.***

At the completion of the drill, barricades will be left in place around these holes for the safety of persons that may be skating, playing ice hockey, etc. We will do our best to operate in an area that doesn't impede on these activities, but it may be necessary for us to do so.
